- Identify and participate in at least 4 volunteer events with mentors in the community.

- Must possess a bachelors degree in social science with social work background strongly recommended.
- Must have 3 to 5 years experience in the field of social work with case management experience.
- Must be bilingual
- Knowledge of principles and techniques of social work including case management, crisis intervention, group facilitation
- Must maintain Texas driver's license and provide proof of automotive liability insurance.
- Must have access to reliable and safe transportation. Driving will be required on a regular basis.
- Ability to engage and effectively communicate with persons from diverse cultures and communities.
- Strong positive communicative skills to engage and work with clients and their families effectively.
