The NFP Nurse Supervisor works within the local community and agency to assure that the NFP program is implemented in accordance with established guidelines and contract requirements.

### **Requirements:**

- Master's Degree in Nursing preferred. A minimum of a Bachelor's degree in nursing with two years paid nursing experience in community, maternal or child health or mental/behavioral health.
- Minimum of 5-8 years of management supervision experience in nursing or a minimum of 3-4 years experience as an NFP Nurse Home Visitor.
- Current RN license in good standing and CPR certification required.
- Proficiency in reading, writing and speaking Spanish preferred not required.
- Experience with supervision and program development.
- Experience in organizing, implementing meetings and activities.
- Proficient in Microsoft office; including MS Word, MS Excel and MS PowerPoint.
- Sufficient maturity and judgment to function in crises.
- Ability to seek supervision and use it constructively.
- Ability to have a joyful approach to children, adolescents and families of diverse cultures.
- Must maintain Texas driver's license and provide proof of automotive liability insurance.
