The Children's Hope Social Worker provides in office and in home support and case management services to children and families who are clients of the Hope Center. Support and case management services will include psycho-education, parent skills training and coaching, and community resource enhancement.

Responsibilities:

- Assess the family environment for needs outside of clinical treatment and develop a case plan with the family to address those needs.
- Provide in-home parenting training utilizing the principles of the Trust-Based Relational Interventions (TBRI) model and other evidence-based parenting models.
- Provide referrals to appropriate community services identified in family case plan.
- Seek community partnerships and resources to enhance the program for clients.
- Schedules visits based upon individual needs and at the convenience of the family. Scheduled visits should include delivery of curricula and coaching, review of family goals, referrals to appropriate resources, and accurate documentation of client contact and progress.

Requirements:

- Bachelor's Degree in Social Work or related field required.
- Required to be trained in Trust-Based Relational Interventions (TBRI) model
- Must have 3 to 5 years experience in the field of social work with case management experience.
- Computer literate with Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, PowerPoint) and Microsoft Outlook.
- Skills in organizing work in a responsible way with multiple challenges and priorities.
- Ability to write clearly, accurately, and descriptively, using appropriate vocabulary, grammar, and language.
- Must maintain a Texas driver's license and provide proof of automotive liability insurance.
- Must have access to reliable and safe transportation. Driving will be required on a regular basis.
- Ability to engage and effectively communicate with person from diverse cultures and communities.
- Strong positive communicative skills to engage and work with children and families effectively.
- Maturity to treat children and their parents with dignity and respect at all times, in all circumstances.
